On September 27, 1972, Konstantin and Elena Martushev submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR 2080, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Records; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 24 gallons of water per minute from a well located within the SE4 NE4 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 4.0 acres within the NW4 NE4 and 13.0 acres within the SW4 NE4 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

On September 29, 1972, Timofey and Agafia Kalugin submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR 2080, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Records; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 29 gallons of water per minute from a well located within the SE4 NE2 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 2.3 acres within the NE4 NE4, 2.0 acres within the NW4 NE4, 4.0 acres within the SW4 NE4 and 11.7 acres within the SE4 NE4, Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

On October 16, 1972, Peter and Eugenia Kalugin submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR 2080, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Records; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 28 gallons per minute of water from a well located within the SE_4^1 NE_4^1 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 17.7 acres within the NE_4^1 NE_4^1 and 2.0 acres within the SE_4^1 NE_4^1 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

On October 16, 1972, Karnily and Agafia Kalugin submitted an affidevit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR 2080, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Records; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 35 gallons per minute of water from a well located within the SE_4^1 NE_4^1 of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 2.3 acres within the SW_4^1 NE_4^1 , 9.3 acres within the SE_4^1 NE_2^1 , 11.0 acres within the NE_4^1 SE_4^1 , and 1.7 acres within the NW_4^1 SE_4^1 , Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

That part of the claimed right described in said certificate for the appropriation of 34 gallons per minute of water from a well for the irrigation of 8.7 acres within the SW_4^1 NE_4^1 , and 15.3 acres within the NW_4^2 SE_4^2 , Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of June, 1947, is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of water rights for the use of not to exceed 116.0 gallons per minute of water from said well for the irrigation of 20.0 acres within the NE $_4^1$ NE $_4^1$, 6.0 acres within

the NW4 NE4, 19.3 acres within the SW4 NE4, 23.0 acres within the SE4 NE4, 1.7 acres within the NW4 SE4, and 11.0 acres within the NE4 SE4, Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of June, 1947, described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR 2080, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Records, is canceled.
