confirms the right of record to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.3 ACRES (A PORTION OF TRACT 22).

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court in the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, Page 291. The date of priority is 1889.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This order is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 17, 2013, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1085, approving Transfer Application 8600, affecting a portion of Certificate 73405, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that it is necessary for record keeping.
