ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 7572 submitted by

JOE AND BARBARA BREWER 28305 GOWDYVILLE ROAD LORANE, OREGON 97451.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 827, was perfected under Permit 423 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 13, 1910. The right allows the use of KELLY'S CREEK, a tributary of the SIUSLAW RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.4 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 30, T 20 S, R 4 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SE% SW% 8.4 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to TEMPORARILY change the place of use to:

SW% SE% 8.4 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

THIS TEMPORARY CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The change is temporary. The change shall be effective immediately. The use of water shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2000 irrigation season.
- The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right during the term of this order.
- The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.

Certificate 827 is suspended until the end of the 2000 irrigation, October 31, 1966, or revocation of the this order, which ever occurs first. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 827.
