An affidavit was received from STEVEN BRAWLEY, acting for the United States Bureau of Reclamation, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 17240, which superseded certificate 2615, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 1.03 cubic feet per second from MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER. The date of priority is 1904. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 82.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 17240 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
