Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.610, 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which the holder of a certificate of registration may submit a request for recognition of modifications to the place of use, character of use or point of appropriation under a groundwater certificate of registration.

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 382 and 380 implement the statutes and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating groundwater registration modification applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On March 27, 2018, KATHLEEN STOCKS filed a groundwater registration modification application to modify the point of appropriation under Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930). The Department assigned the application number T-12891.
2. On May 9, 2014, Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) was partially diminished to supplemental irrigation by Special Order Volume 92, page 375, approving Transfer Application T-11605.
3. On February 25, 2015, Groundwater Modification Application T-11854 was approved and recorded at Special Order Volume 95, page 127 recognizing a modification in point of appropriation.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. On August 14, 2015, Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) was partially diminished to supplemental irrigation under Special Order Volume 109, page 98, approving Transfer Application T-12561.
5. On April 10, 2018, Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) was partially assigned from Robinson Nursery Inc. to Robinson Nursery Inc. and Kathleen M. Stocks.
6. Notice of the application for groundwater registration modification was published on April 17, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
7. On October 18, 2019, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12891 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of November 17, 2019 for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the Groundwater Registration Modification.
8. On January 8, 2020, the portion of Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) in the name of Kathleen M. Stocks was assigned from Kathleen M. Stocks to Mark R. Stocks.
9. On February 11, 2020, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12891 and sent a copy to the applicant.
10. On February 12, 2020, it was discovered that the Preliminary Determination contained two scrivener's errors. Well 2 was incorrectly included as a source being modified and condition number 4 incorrectly identified the water diverted as an additional point of appropriation.
11. On February 27, 2020, the Department issued a Revised Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12891 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the Groundwater Registration Modification application was published on the Department's weekly notice on February 18, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. (No) protests were filed in response to the notice.

12. The portion of the groundwater registration to be modified is as follows:

Registration: Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930), in the name of ROBINSON NURSERY INC. *partially assigned to MARK R. STOCKS*

Use: IRRIGATION of 5.8 ACRES

Tentative

Priority Date: JULY 31, 1954

Quantity: 17.7 GALLONS PER MINUTE

Source: WELL 1 within the SALT CREEK BASIN

13. Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12891 proposes to modify the point of appropriation approximately 0.1 mile from the original point of appropriation to:

5 S	4 W	WM	7	NE NE	7	STOCKS WELL 2 - 1270 FEET SOUTH AND 1075 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 7

Review Criteria for Groundwater Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

14. The proposed modification would not result in enlargement of the groundwater registration.

15. The proposed modification would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.

16. The proposed modification would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The modification in point of appropriation proposed in Groundwater Registration Modification T-12891 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-1000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The modification to Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) proposed in Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12891 is recognized. Recognition of the modification shall not be construed as a final determination of the right to appropriate groundwater under the certificate of registration or modification. Such a determination will occur in an adjudication proceeding under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.
2. The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-2000 (Certificate of Registration GR-1930) and any related decree.
3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
4. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed point of appropriation (Stocks Well 2), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 1).
