ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6638 submitted by

SINN BROTHERS
9821 SARATOGA DRIVE SE
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 36223, was perfected under Permit G-3616 with a date of priority of MARCH 10, 1967. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.21 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within HEADRICK DLC 44, SECTION 24, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 17.0 ACRES

as projected within HEADRICK DLC 44
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within HEADRICK DLC 44, SECTION 24, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2150 FEET NORTH AND 1450 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER DLC 42.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the lawful quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 36223 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
