BEFORE THE STATE ENGINEER OF OREGON Marion County

Water right Certificate No. 3556 was issued in confirmation of Permit No. 1216, granting the right to the use of water for the irrigation of 30 acres in the $NW_4^1SE_4^1$, 10 of which were shown on the accompanying map as being within the $NW_4^1NW_4^1SE_4^1$ of Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M. and other lands, and Certificate No. 5548 was issued in confirmation of Permit No. E-170, granting the right to the use of water for the irrigation of 20 acres in the $SE_4^1SE_4^1$ of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M. and other lands.

It now appears that due to errors in the maps and applications under which these permits were issued, that the permits did not properly describe the lands which the company desired to obtain a water right for and that it was the intent of the company to obtain a right to the use of water for the irrigation of 10 acres in the NE4NW4SE4 of Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M. under Permit No. 1216, Certificate No. 3556, instead of the NW4NW4SE4, and that it was also the intent of the company to obtain a right to the use of water for the irrigation of 20 acres in the NE4NE4 of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, F. M. under Permit No. E-170, Certificate No. 3548, instead of the SE4SE4 of Section 29, and

It appearing that it was the full intent and purpose of the company to obtain a right for the irrigation of the latter described lands and that the rights of no other parties will be injured by correcting these certificates,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that water right Certificates Nos. 3556 and 3548 be and the same are hereby cancelled and that new certificates be issued making the proper corrections.
