O R D E R

On October 19, 1978, Robert G. and Gloria A. Herman submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain water rights and the real property to which the water rights are appurtenant; that they have initiated the transfer of the primary water right away from said real property and authorize the Water Resources Director to clear the supplemental right from the records of his office.


The supplemental water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 37341, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oakhill Potato Farms, and is for the use of stored water only from two reservoirs constructed under permit No. R-2992, with a priority date of August 31, 1962, for the supplemental irrigation of 2.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 1 West W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said supplemental water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 37341, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
