O R D E R

On October 17, 1978, William H. Volker submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.


The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 38028, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of William H. Volker, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second of water from Martin's Lake, with a date of priority of May 8, 1963, for irrigation of 0.5 acre in Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), 7.5 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 7.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Lafferty D. L. C. No. 46 of Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

O. R. S. 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 38028, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
