O R D E R

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing:

That on February 17, 1926, application for permit was filed by Benton Carter of Long Creek, Oregon, and subsequently permit was issued covering a right to appropriate water from Pole Creek and Gander Creek, for the irrigation of lands in Section 32, T. 10 S. R. 31 E.W.M. Thereafter the permittee constructed his irrigation works and irrigated the land as originally contemplated and after having made final proof, obtained Certificate 7080 covering the right to 4/10 second foot of water for the irrigation of 22 acres of land in Section 32 of said township and range. Said appropriator has now discovered that such irrigated lands were erroneously described in his original application due to an error in location of the land made by the surveyor who prepared the map which accompanied the application. The official surveys and maps made by the State Engineer in connection with the John Day River adjudication proceeding correctly show the location and area of such irrigated lands, as follows: 6.8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 0.3 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 16.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 0.9 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T. 10 S. R. 31 E. W. M.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that former certificate covering such water right be and the same is hereby cancelled and a new certificate issued correctly describing said lands.
