ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6507 submitted by

DELBERT HAENER 11644 EHLEN ROAD NE AURORA, OREGON 97002.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 60729, was perfected under Permit G-8997 with a date of priority of JANUARY 7, 1980. The right allows the use of WELL 2, a tributary of SENECAL CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 69.6 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.87 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE \{ NE%, as projected within DLC 61, SECTION 17, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; WELL 2 - 2450 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 17, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE 3 SW 3 5.4 ACRES NW 3 SW 3 25.4 ACRES as projected within DLC 61 SECTION 16

SE NE 8.2 ACRES NE¼ SE¾ 30.4 ACRES SE SE 0.2 ACRE as projected within DLC 61 SECTION 17

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

NE SE, as projected within DLC 61, SECTION 17, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1150 FEET NORTH AND 740 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 62.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 60729 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
