ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.580, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7668 submitted by

Westland Irrigation District P.O. Box 416 Stanfield, Oregon 97875

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County tabulated under the name of Westland Irrigation District. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources director in Volume 15, Page 378. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1907.

The right allows the use of UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.75 acres. The applicant, an IRRIGATION DISTRICT has requested a change in place of use of the rights listed in FROM LANDS TABLE to the locations listed in TO LANDS TABLE.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The "FROM" lands will receive no water under the rights involved with T-7668.
- 3. The "FROM" lands will receive no water under any other rights appurtenant to these lands, unless water rights are transferred to the "FROM" lands.
- 4. Following proof to the satisfaction of the director of the completion of the transfer approved in this order, the Department may amend or cancel the certificate pertinent to this transfer. If the certificate is canceled, a new certificate will be issued preserving the priority date, rate, duty, and use of the canceled certificate. The new certificate will list the "TO" lands approved in this order within the Place of Use listing.
- 5. Pursuant to ORS 540.580(13), the water right pertinent to the "TO" lands shall not be involved in a permanent transfer under ORS 540.580 for a period of five years after the date of this order.
