An affidavit was received from Robert L. and Ellen M. Nickerson, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. A portion of the water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 4294, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of water from Powder River, a tributary of Snake River. The dates of priority are 1880, 1899, and 1902. The abandoned water right is for Powder River only.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 4294 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
