On August 12, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert K. Beesley for approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The documents identifying the water rights on which said change was based were not adequately described in the order of the Water Resources Director approving the change in place of use, dated October 19, 1981, and entered at pages 292 and 293, Volume 35, Special Order Record.

Transfer 2611, recorded at page 35, Volume 22, Special Order Record, allowed a change in place of use for irrigation of 40.0 acres to the NW I/4 NE I/4, Section 17, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, WM, as noted in line 5, paragraph 2, page 292.

The 30.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, WM, noted in said line 5, was allowed by Decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County, entered November 19, 1913, and tabulated in the name of Walter Ruble at page 428, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, as evidenced by the certificate of water right recorded at page 850, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Transfer C-45, entered at page 229, Volume I, Special Order Records, allowed a change in place of use for irrigation of 11.0 acres to SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, WM, as noted in lines 5 and 6, paragraph 2, page 292, Volume 35, Special Order Record.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the order of the Water Resources Director entered October 19, 1981 at pages 292 and 293, Volume 35, Special Order Record, approving Transfer 4866, be amended as stated herein.
