On May 15, 1975, William G. and Joy L. Stuivenga filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Mill Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to William P. Harris and recorded at Page 20966, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.248 cubic foot per second of water from Mill Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 4.9 acres in NE NW4, and 2.2 acres in NW2 NW2, Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 12, 1945. 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Mr. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Mill Creek, to wit:

From a point located 600 feet North and 2400 feet West from the Southeast corner of Blair D.I.C. #41, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 720 feet North and 2450 feet West from the Southeast corner of Blair D.L.C. #41, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.,

for the irrigation of 4.9 acres in NE¹₄ NW¹₄ and 2.2 acres in NW¹₄ NW¹₄, Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 12, 1945, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1976.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.089 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. The balance of the right not involved in this proceeding for the irrigation of 7.1 acres is included in an application filed by George J. and Herta L. Riggs.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to William P. Harris and recorded at Page 20966, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the change in point of diversion authorized herein, a certificate of water right shall be issued to William G. and Joy L. Stuivenga confirming the change in point of diversion.
