ORDER
APPROVING APPLICATION

On May 19, 1934, Bertha Patjens Heese filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek.

In the adjudication proceedings involving the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of Charles Hindman for the irrigation of 17 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 28.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W. M. with a date of priority of 1871. A water right was also recognized in the name of Martha A. Hindman for the irrigation of 30.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 3, same township and range, with a date of priority of 1903.

The applicant herein, owner of the above described lands, proposes to transfer the water rights appurtenant thereto and to be made appurtenant to the following described lands:

10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 28,
Township 14 South, Range 10 East, W. M.,

with a date of priority of 1871 and to

5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 21;

10 acres in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄
10 acres in the NE¹/₄SE¹/₄
Section 28,
Township 14 South, Range 10 East, W. M.

with a date of priority of 1903.

Notice for publication as provided by Section 47-712,
Oregon Code 1930, is not required in applications for only a
change in place of use of water.

It further appearing that the proposed change in place
of use of water can be effected without injury to existing rights,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change
in place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved without
loss of priority of the right as heretofore established.
