3. Application T-9651 proposes to change the place of use of the right to:

4. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
5. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
6. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
7. A portion of Certificate 68705 not modified by this transfer is proposed for transfer under application T-9613.

**Conclusions of Law**


The changes in place of use proposed in application T-9651 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The change(s) in place of use proposed in application T-9651 are approved.
2. Water right certificate 68705 is cancelled. A new certificate shall be issued describing the portion of Certificate 68705 not affected by this transfer and transfer T-9613.
3. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 68705 and any related decree.
4. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2006.
5. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2007.
6. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

7. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
8. All further correspondence shall be sent to the receiving landowners, Carl & Barbara Stiff.
9. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
