IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF DAVID STUTZMAN FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3013

On April 5, 1974, David Stutzman filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Otto P. Brandt and recorded at page 39112, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 1.07 cubic feet per second of water from South Yamhill River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 8.2 acres in NW4 SW4, and 6.8 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 25, 1969. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 630 feet North and 630 feet West from the Northwest corner of McCane DIC 62, being within Lot 1 (NW4 SW4), Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 75 feet South and 125 feet West from the Northeast corner of James M. Graves DIC 75, being within the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said Section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District #1, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from South Yamhill River, to wit:

From a point located 630 feet North and 630 feet West from the Northwest corner of McCane DIC 62, being within Lot 1 ( $NW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ ), of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 75 feet South and 125 feet West from the Northeast corner of James M. Graves DIC 75, being within the  $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$  SW $_{\frac{1}{4}}$  of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 8.2 acres in NW1 SW2, and 6.8 acres in SW1 SW1,
Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority
of September 25, 1969, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1975.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Otto P. Brandt and recorded at page 39112, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to David Stutzman confirming the change in point of diversion.
