ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3220

On May 5, 1975, George J. and Herta L. Riggs filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Mill Creek, pursuant to the provision of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to William P. Harris and recorded at Page 24750, Volume 17, State Record of Water right certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.24 cubic feet per second of water from Mill Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 0.7 acre in NW4 NE4, 2.6 acres in SW4 NE4, 3.2 acres in NE4 NW4, 9.2 acres in SE4 NW4, and 0.8 acre in NE4 SW4, Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W. M., with a date of priority of March 18, 1953. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 730 feet South and 1960 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Blair D.L.C. # hl, being within the SE4 NW4, Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 310 feet South and 1530 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Blair D.L.C. # 41, being within the  $SE_2^1$   $NW_2^1$ , Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section

provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there is no intervening diversion.

Mr. Gene McCinnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Mill Creek, to wit:

From a point located 730 feet South and 1960 feet West from the Southeast corner of Blair D.L.C. #  $\mu$ 1, being within the SE4  $W_4$  of Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

To a point to be located 310 feet South and 1530 feet West from the Southeast corner of Blair D.L.C. # Ll, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W. M.,

for the irrigation of 0.7 acre in  $NW_4^2$   $NE_4^1$ , 2.6 acres in  $SW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 3.2 acres in  $NE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$ , 9.2 acres in  $SE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$ , and 0.8 acre in  $NE_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W. M., with a date of priority of March 18, 1953, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1976.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.205 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to William P. Harris and recorded at Page 21750, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to George J. and Herta L. Riggs confirming the change in point of diversion.
