PLACE OF USE OF WATER)

On June 5, 1986, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William F. Glimm, Jr. for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Proof has been submitted to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that Transfer S-186, in the name of Walt B. Schrock, for the use of water from Deschutes River for irrigation of 2.0 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, WM, with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, has been completed.

Said lands are a portion of the right evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Swalley Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 2.0 acres in Tax Lot 5300 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, WM (Phil Peterson).

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company and the Board of Directors of said Company approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in Certificate 29054, and shall be beneficially used as authorized by this order on or before October 1, 1988.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change of water right shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 29054.
