

3. Application T-9953 proposes to change the place of use of the right to:

4. The right proposed for transfer is supplemental to GR-810. The proposed place of use has an existing primary water right under Certificate 30708. The primary water rights are similar and, as a result, use of the supplemental right will not be increased.
5. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
9. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(6) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law


The temporary change in place of use proposed in application T-9953 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in place of use proposed in application T-9953 is approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2005 irrigation season.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2005 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificate 65958 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.

6. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 65958.
7. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
8. When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
9. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 65958 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 65958.
