ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE
AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7619 submitted by

EDWIN A. HOPPER
25793 EAST BRIGHT AVENUE
WELCHES, OREGON 97067.

The permit to be modified is Permit R-11622 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 2, 1990 FOR 3.40 ACRE-FEET AND NOVEMBER 9, 1995 FOR 0.20 ACRE-FEET. The permit allows the use of UNNAMED STREAMS AND DRAINAGES, tributaries of the SALMON RIVER, for RECREATION TO BE MAINTAINED UNDER PERMITS G-11087 AND G-11283. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.6 ACRE-FEET, if available at the authorized point of diversion: RESERVOIR #1 (A&B) DAM - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 4, T 3 S, R 7 E, W.M.; 3920 FEET SOUTH AND 2420 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use (reservoir) is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the place of use (reservoir) to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion (dam) to:

NE¼ SW¼, SECTION 4, T 3 S, R 7 E, W.M.; 1640 FEET NORTH AND 2450 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 4.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (dam) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (dam).
2. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion (dam).
3. The former place of use (reservoir) shall no longer be used as a part of this water right.
4. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.

Permit R-11622, in the name of EDWIN A. HOPPER, RRR GOLF INC., is amended as described herein.
