FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A Short-Term Lease Application was submitted to the Department by:

- 2. The Instream Lease Application (the Application) included the required fees. The Department assigned this Application lease agreement number L-480.
- 3. The Application proposed to lease a portion of certificate 53001 and all of certificates 53000, T-4431, 7641, 2432, 2412, 45299, and 67090 for instream purposes. Under Certificate 53001, the Lessor and Lessee (together "the Applicant") requested to lease the entire right instream with the exception of a small portion, 0.5 Cubic Foot per Second (CFS) to be used for stockwatering purposes.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

4. The Application proposed to lease water instream under each of the water rights identified in Finding 3 as follows:

- 5. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6) on December 23, 2003. No comments were received during the open comment period, which ended January 13, 2004. On March 18, 2004, the Department received a letter from Martha Pagel, on behalf of Roger Nicholson, asserting that this proposed lease and Instream Lease Application L-479 would result in injury to water rights held by Mr. Nicholson.
- 6. On May 3, 2004, the Department received from the KBRT an April 30, 2004, letter from Martha Pagel, on behalf of Roger Nicholson, additionally indicating that that the proposed lease would result in enlargement of the water rights to be leased.
- 7. The Department reviewed Ms. Pagel's letters but did not find that the lease would result in injury or enlargement.
- 8. Ms. Pagel indicated in her April 30, 2004, letter that if Mr. Nicholson's concerns on Sevenmile Creek (Instream Lease Application L-479) were addressed, he would not pursue any objections to the lease of water instream in Annie Creek.
- 9. On August 12, 2004, Department staff met with the Applicant, Mr. Nicholson and their respective counsel. As a result of this discussion, the parties reached a stipulated agreement.

- 10. Based upon continued evaluation of the Application, the Department has also found the following:
 - a. The instream lease application submitted to the Department, requested that a portion of water normally diverted for irrigation be left out of the lease for certificate 53001 (0.5 CFS) to supply stockwater. However, the Annie Creek decree, under which this certificate was issued, limits the diversion of water for stock or domestic purposes. The Decree states that during the irrigation season such appropriations shall not be entitled to any water for stock or domestic purposes in addition to the quantity which they are entitled to divert for irrigation. If the entire irrigation portion of the water right is being leased instream during the irrigation season, no water may be diverted for livestock use.
 - b. On June 30, 2004, the Lessee requested to amend the lease application to withdraw 40.0 acres of irrigated lands under certificate 53001 to provide for some irrigation and livestock water during the irrigation season.
 - c. The instream lease application requests to lease water under approved Transfer Application T-4413 (Special Order Volume 35, Page 365) to instream use. Since this application was filed, confirming rights for this transfer application, certificate 80582 and 80583, have been issued. The lease will be modified to appropriately describe the quantities of water to be leased instream under each of these certificates.
 - d. Pursuant to findings in the Wood River Decree, the priority dates on lands covered by certificates 45299 (permit S-8029) and 7641 (permit S-8029) should be 1900. See finding 3 of the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269. To reflect the corrections made in the Wood River Decree to the priority date of these rights, water will be leased instream under the 1900 priority date. In addition, the instream lease application identified portions of these certificates as being supplemental to certificates 10900, 2412 and 80582 (formerly described as T-4413). Certificates 10900 and 80582 have priority dates of 1898 and are considered primary. However, certificate 2412 has a priority date of 1914 and is considered supplemental for the purposes of this lease. The instream lease will be modified to clarify the quantities of water to be leased instream under certificate 45299 and 2412, including primary and supplemental quantities.
 - e. The 4.5 acres described as supplemental for certificate 45299 in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 1, Township 33 South, Range 6 East, appears to be appurtenant to lands covered by certificate 2412 rather than certificate 80582. Given the above finding, these 4.5 acres will be considered primary for certificate 45299 and supplemental for certificate 2412.
 - f. The irrigation season described in the lease application for each right needs clarification. The irrigation season under the Anna Creek Decree is May 1 through October 31, unless otherwise specified on the certificate.
 - g. The quantities of supplemental water to be leased instream under certificate 67090 required clarification. Portions of this certificate are supplemental to certificates 53001, 80582 (T-4413) and 80583 (T-4413). The applicant requested that water be leased instream when needed to make up a deficiency in these primary rights. While each of these certificates has an 1883 priority date, the quantity of associated supplemental water

for each certificate needs to be described. In addition, certificate 67090 has one allowed rate prior to July 20th and another allowed rate after July 20th for supplemental irrigation. The information provided in the Application does not reflect this rate change and the lease will be modified to reflect this rate change.

11. Based upon continued evaluation and findings made in Finding 10 above, the Department has determined that the lease application requires modification in order to clarify water rights to be leased. The rights to be leased are clarified as follows (all changes to the Application are shown in bold text):

13. The Department finds that a portion of the water right described in the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3 (also see certificate 45299) is supplemental to certificate 10900 (see Instream Lease L-479). The portion of the water right described in the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3 (also see certificate 45299) being leased instream that is supplemental shall only be protected instream when necessary to make up a deficiency of the rate and duty of the primary supply under certificate 10900 during the period for which water is being leased instream.

- 14. The Department finds that a portion of the water right described in the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3 (also see certificate 7641) is supplemental to certificate 10900 (see Instream Lease L-479). The portion of the water right described in the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3 (also see certificate 7641) being leased instream that is supplemental shall only be protected instream when necessary to make up a deficiency of the rate and duty of the primary supply under certificate 10900 during the period for which water is being leased instream.
- 15. The Department finds that a portion of certificate 2412 is supplemental to the water right described in the Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3 (also see certificate 45299). The portion of certificate 2412 being leased instream that is supplemental shall only be protected instream when necessary to make up a deficiency of the rate and duty of the primary supply under certificate 10900 during the period for which water is being leased instream.
- 16. The Department finds that a portion of certificate 67090 is supplemental to certificates 53001, 80582 and 80583. The portion of certificate 67090 being leased instream that is supplemental shall only be protected instream when necessary to make up a deficiency of the respective rates and duties of the primary supply under certificates 53001, 80582 and/or 80583 during the period for which water is being leased instream.
- 17. Based upon review of the application, comments received, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease, as modified, will not result in injury or enlargement.
- 18. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2008. The lessor has requested the option of terminating the lease early, prior to the lease being exercised (April 1), with 30 days written notice to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease, as modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement, pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. That Short-Term Lease L-480 described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. The authorized place, as described in the instream lease application and as modified in Finding 11 in the Findings of Fact Section, of use shall not be irrigated during the term of this lease under certificates 53000, 53001, 80582, 80583, 2431, 2412, 67090, and Wood River Decree, Volume 12, Page 269, Finding 3.

- 8. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2008. The lessor shall have the option of terminating the lease each year, prior to the lease being exercised (April 1), with 30 days written notice to the Department. In addition, the lease may be modified by the parties as provided in Paragraph VII. of the Stipulated Agreement, or the lease shall be terminated by the Department, as provided therein, if the lease is determined by the Department to result in injury or enlargement that cannot be prevented by modifying the lease terms.
