ORDER
EXTENDING TIME LIMIT

The City of Forest Grove is the holder of permit No. 17549 which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 7.0 cubic feet per second from Gales Creek for municipal use.

The time for completion of construction work and complete application of water under the permit expired October 1, 1965.

The City has submitted an application for extension of time limits within which to complete construction work and make complete application of water to beneficial use under their permit.

The State Engineer is authorized under the provisions of ORS 537.230 to grant extensions of time for good cause shown, within which to complete work or perfect a right under a water right permit.

The statements in the application for extension filed regarding completion of the project indicate that such reasonable diligence has been shown as entitles the City to an extension of time.

No protests or objections to the granting of an extension under the permit have been filed by any subsequent permit holders.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limit in which to complete construction work and make complete application of water under the terms of permit No. 17549 be extended to October 1, 1970.
