ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER 5067

On June 7, 1982, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jack McEntire for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of U. S. Reclamation Service, describes a right which includes the use of water from Umatilla River, for irrigation of 2.0 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 13, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1909.

Water for the said right is diverted through the West Extension Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof another 2.0 acres in said SE 1/4 NE 1/4.

Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this and other orders, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to U. S. Reclamation Service, or their successor in interest.
