The lands from which the 1895 water rights are being transferred are rocky and rolling in topography wherein the lands to which the 1895 rights are being transferred are level and more adaptable to irrigation.

All of the lands involved belong to the applicants herein and are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District, which district has submitted its written approval of such exchange.

Notice for publication as provided by Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1930, is not required for an application for a change in place and use of water, and it appearing that such exchange can be made without injury to existing rights,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said exchange of water rights be and the same is hereby approved without loss of the priority of the rights heretofore established and shall become appurtenant to the lands as described in the above tabulation.
