## ORDER APPROVING

APPLICATION NO. S-46

On September 27, 1946, Donald Dawson Sloper of Star Route, Glendale, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

Certificate of Water Right recorded at Page 6677, Volume 7,
State Record of Water Right Certificates was issued to J. E. and O. F.
Nichols confirming a right to the use of 0.88 cubic feet per second of
water from Cow Creek for the irrigation of 2.25 acres in the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 22.75
acres in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 19; 14 acres in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and 20 acres
in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 20; all in Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,
with a date of priority of January 22, 1923. The above lands are irrigated
through the J. E. and O. F. Nichols ditch, the point of diversion of said
ditch being located approximately 220 feet north and 310 feet west from the
south quarter corner of Section 20, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the above described lands and water right appurtenant thereto, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a portable pumping plant on his property along Cow Creek between the east line of the  $SW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , Section 20 and to west line of the  $SE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , Section 19, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-600, O. C. I. A., was given in the Roseburg News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, for a period of at least three weeks and not less than one publication each week, being the issues of October 25, November 1 and 8, 1946, the date set for hearing in said notice being not less than thirty days after the date of the last publication.

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No objections having been filed, and it appearing that such change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Cow Creek, to-wit:

From a point located approximately 220 feet north and 310 feet west from the south quarter corner of Section 20, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,

To any point along Cow Creek on his property between the east line of the  $SW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , Section 20, and the west line of the  $SE_4^1$ ,  $SE_4^1$ , Section 19, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,

for the irrigation of 2.25 acres in the  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , 22.75 acres in the  $SE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , Section 19; 14 acres in the  $NW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , and 20 acres in the  $SW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , Section 20; all in Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M., with a date of priority of January 22, 1923, be and the same hereby is approved.
