On January 26, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by George Harth for approval of a change in place of use of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.260(2), proof has been made to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that a right has been perfected under the terms of Permit G-7258 in the name of George Harth, for the use of not to exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second from Harth Well No. 2, for irrigation of a certain 0.3 acre in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 0.9 acre in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 26.8 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM, with a date of priority of July 16, 1976.

Harth Well No. 2 is located 1620 feet North and 1320 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 26, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 22.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 6.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM.

Thomas J. Paul, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
