
On August 26, 1985, Michael J. Tennant submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered September 30, 1958, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River, tabulated in the name of James Jewell, at page 159, Volume 16, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company, and is for the use of water from Deschutes River, with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, for irrigation of a certain 11.9 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 6.4 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 6.3 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
