IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF W. H.) GORHAM AND OTHERS FOR THE APPROVAL OF A) ORDER CHANGE IN THE POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER)

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of W. H. Gorham, Arthur L. Gorham, J. A. Nice, Matts Nice and J. H. Nice, the facts appearing as follows:

The decree entered in the adjudication of rights to the waters of Powder River and its tributaries recognized certain water rights from Wolf Creek under the names of H. O. Gorham and J. C. Shields for the irrigation of the following lands: SE¹/₄ of Section 7, NE¹/₄ and NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 18, N¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄, Section 17, Twp. 6 S. R. 39 E., W.M. Under these rights the waters of Wolf Creek have been diverted heretofore through the Bridge Ditch, having its head in the NW¹/₄ Nw¹/₄, Section 18, Twp. 6 S. R. 39 E., W.M.

Application has now been filed under which it is proposed to change the diversion point so as to take the water from Wolf Creek at a point approximately 11 rods West of the North and South quarter line in said Section 18, which will change the point of diversion about one-half mile down stream on said Wolf Creek.

Notice of the filing of said application has been given by the State Engineer by publication as provided by Chapter 219, Laws of Oregon for 1927, and no objections thereto have been filed.

It further appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to the rights of other appropriators, it is ORDERED that said change be, and the same is hereby, approved.
