ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4496

On May 9, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by City of Roseburg for approval of a change in place of use from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 41523, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of City of Roseburg, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River for irrigation of a certain 0.1 acre in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13 and 0.7 acre in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, both as projected within Leiser DLC 53, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 11, 1971.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 950 feet North and 190 feet West from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 0.8 acre in ^ESW 1/4 ^ESW 1/4, Section 14, as projected within Leiser DLC 53, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M. *on map map f
band by F.D.
SKB*

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 41523, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
