On February 5, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jerry A. Brewer for approval of a change in place of use of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 34276, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ernest R. Cramer, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 1.38 cubic feet per second from a well for irrigation of 9.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 3.5 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 3.5 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 9.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 39.1 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 40.2 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 13.4 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 24.3 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, WM, with a date of priority of March 11, 1959.

The authorized point of appropriation is located 1,380 feet North and 1,320 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof 32.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 32.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 32.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 32.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 7.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 7.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, WM.

Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1982.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 34276, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
