Now at this time this matter coming on before the State Water Board on the application of F. A. Wagner, and it appearing:

That on the 10th day of February, 1922, Certificate of Water Right No. 3542 was issued to the Alder Slope Ditch Company, under Permit No. 4805, covering among other lands, a right for 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, T 2 S. R. 44 E. W. M., from Hurricane Creek. [That the applicant above named now asks a transfer of one-half of this right to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section, both of said tracts being now owned by him.

That an investigation of this matter has been made and report submitted to the Board, by the Water Master for said district.

That it is impracticable to use all of said water right on the land to which it is now appurtenant, and that a change in the place of use would not cause injury to other rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board having considered said application and being now fully advised in the premises, it is ORDERED, that said transfer be and the same is hereby approved, and that a right for 10 acres of the land now covered by said 20 acre water right in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 9, T 2 S. R. 44 E. W. M., be and the same is hereby severed from said lands, and is hereby transferred, and by this transfer becomes appurtenant, without loss of priority, to 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
