ORDER DENYING EXTENSION OF TIME REQUEST

AND LOSS OF WATER RIGHT

Transfer 6252, in the name of Clinton and Mary Ann Basey, allowed the change in point of appropriation and place of use of 0.22 cubic foot per second of water from a Well in the Silver Creek Basin for the irrigation of 17.52 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, T 28 S, R 14 E, WM. The change was to have been completed by October 1, 1991.

On October 29, 1993, the Department received a request for an extension of time to complete the change. The request indicated that the applicants have been unable to find a well driller willing to repair the well. The request also indicated that the applicants have not installed the irrigation system, nor run power to the well.


It appears the applicants have not exercised reasonable diligence in trying to complete the project. Therefore, the request for extension of time is DENIED.

The changes allowed in the order of the Water Resources Director, entered December 28, 1990, recorded at Special Order Volume 44, Pages 482 and 483, approving Transfer 6252, were not made, based on the request for extension of time. The extension of time request has been denied. Satisfactory proof of the completed changes has not been submitted as required by the order.

In accordance with the provisions of OAR 690-15-090, the water right described in the order approving Transfer 6252, and herein, is LOST, and of no further force or effect.
