On September 19, 1934, the Milton-Freewater Hudson Bay Irrigation Company filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from the Walla Walla River.

In the adjudication proceedings involving the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of the Walla Walla River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Milton-Freewater Hudson Bay Irrigation Company for the irrigation of, among other lands, 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, W. M., with a date of priority of February 16, 1903.

That the applicant herein proposes to transfer the water right appurtenant to 10 acres of the above described land to 5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, W. M.

Notice for publication as provided by Section 47-712 Oregon Code 1930 is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.

It further appears that the Milton-Freewater Hudson Bay Irrigation Company, through whose ditch the water is delivered to the lands from which it is proposed to make the transfer, and the Walla Walla Irrigation Company, the record owner of the lands from which the water is being transferred, have submitted their approval in writing to such transfer,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said change in place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved, without loss of the priority heretofore established.
