Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 28, 2013, RICHARD ROBINSON filed an application to change the place of use under Certificate 22179. The Department assigned the application number T-11605.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 4, 2013, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. The Department determined that the land to which Certificate 22179 is proposed to move to is already covered by a groundwater registration, GR-2000, for irrigation use.
4. On January 28, 2014, the applicant submitted an Affidavit for the Partial Diminution of a Water Right Certificate for Groundwater Registration GR-2000.
5. On February 13, 2014, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11605 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of March 13, 2014, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. On March 24, 2014, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11605 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on April 1, 2014, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-0020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

7. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 22179 in the name of CHARLIE W. REED (perfected under Permit S-19336)
Use: IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES
Priority Date: SEPTEMBER 14, 1949
Rate: 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND
Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

8. Transfer Application T-11605 proposes to change the place of use of the right to:

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11605.
11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Partial Diminution of a Groundwater Registration

On January 28, 2014, the applicant submitted an Affidavit for the Partial Diminution of a Groundwater Registration. The portion of the registration to be diminished is as follows:

Use: IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES
Tentative Priority Date: JULY 1954
Rate: 12.2 GALLONS PER MINUTE
Source: A WELL, tributary to SALT CREEK

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11605 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 and GR-2000 should be partially diminished.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11605 is approved. Groundwater Registration GR-2000 is partially diminished.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 22179 and any related decree.
3. Water right certificate 22179 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.

4. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. **Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
5. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2015**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
7. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
