IN THE POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER.)

Now, at this time, this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of W. H. Gorham and Arthur L. Gorham, by their agent, Mr. E. J. Sencerbox, the facts appearing as follows:

The decree entered in the adjudication of rights to the waters of Powder River and its tributaries recognized certain water rights from Wolf Creek under the name of H. O. Gorham for the irrigation of the following lands: The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, W.M. Under these rights the waters of Wolf Creek have been diverted heretofore through the Gorham-Gilkison Ditch, having its head on the south bank of Wolf Creek about 200 feet west of the north and south section line, between Sections 13 and 14 in Township 6 South, Range 38 East, and within the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 13.

Application has now been filed under which it is proposed to change the diversion point so as to take the water from Wolf Creek at a point approximately 11 rods west of the north and south quarter line of Section 18, T. 6 S. R. 39 E., and within the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 18, which will change the point of diversion about $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile downstream on said Wolf Creek.


Notice of the filing of said application has been given by the State Engineer by publication as provided by Chapter 219, Laws of Oregon for 1927. Objections thereto were filed by the United States Investment Company but were afterward withdrawn after amicable settle-

ment had been made between the parties.

It further appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to the rights of other appropriators, it is ORDERED that said change be, and the same is hereby, approved.
