Findings of Fact

- 1. On February 3, 1997, Walla Walla River Irrigation District filed a transfer to add a point of diversion to Certificates 12961, 12944, 13057, 12888, 13003, 13080, 13023, 13010, 55844, 13030, 13008, 12965, 12966, 13065, 12940, 13020, 12992, 12993, 12984, 13077, 13052, 13041, 13046, 52832, 52833, 54771, 33675, 12988 and 12954. The Department assigned the application number T-7700.
- 2. On August 7, 2002, the Department issued an order approving the proposed additional point of diversion. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Pages 803 823.
- 3. Walla Walla River Irrigation District notified the Department that the changes authorized under Transfer Application T-7700 would not be completed and requested that the authorized points of diversion revert back to the original points of diversion.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The additional point of diversion authorized under Transfer Application T-7700 is reverted to the points of diversion authorized under the water rights prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the rights affected by the transfer shall be issued.
