ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3824

On October 14, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John Olson for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified in accordance with the provisions of the order of the State Engineer entered June 13, 1952 approving transfer application No. L-41, a water right allowed by the State Engineer's findings In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Deschutes River and its Tributaries in the name of Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company, being tabulated in the name of James Lempke, now exists for the use of the waters of Deschutes River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 1.0 acre in NE¼ NE¼ of Section 29 and in the NW¼ NW¾ of Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Swalley Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.0 acre in SW4 NW4 of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company and the Board of Directors of said Company approved the proposed change in place of use at a meeting held August 1, 1977.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of

use of water from Deschutes River, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company at the time certificate is issued to the Company confirming other transfers within the Company.
