On August 12, 1981, Bill Uhl and C. R. Graham submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated in the name of G. W. Fuller, at page 127, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 302, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, and is for the use of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of November, 1904, for irrigation of 8.0 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 302, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
