Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On January 4, 2021, GLENN F. WOODBURY filed an application to change the place of use and to change the character of use under Certificate 4903. The Department assigned the application number T-13592.
- 2. On April 16, 2021, a partial assignment of Transfer Application T-13592 from GLENN F. WOODBURY to TRIN CORP ROTH 401(K) JAMES BEARD was recorded.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 26, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. On September 22, 2021, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13592 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of October 22, 2021, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 5. On November 9, 2021, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13592 and sent a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on November 16, 2021, and in the Grants Pass Daily Courier newspaper on November 16 and 23, 2021, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 4903 in the name of H. B. HENDRICKS AND WM. H. WOODBURY

(perfected under Permit S-4471)

Use: IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES

Priority Date: FEBRUARY 17, 1920

Rate: 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in

case of rotation.

7. The Department received information from the applicant that describes the location of the authorized point of diversion as being:

- 8. Transfer Application T-13592 proposes to change the character of use for 1.0 acre listed in Finding of Fact #6 from Irrigation of 1.0 acre to Group Domestic from April 1 to November 1.
- 9. Transfer Application T-13592 also proposes to change the place of use of the right to:

- 10. Certificate 4903 does not specify the irrigation season, however the Illinois River Decree defines the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1.
- 11. The total volume of water that may be diverted for Group Domestic uses, as conditioned, is limited to 3.5 Acre-Feet (AF) April through October. (3.5 AF/acre x 1.0 acre = 3.5 AF).

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 12. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 13. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13592.
- 14. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 15. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13592 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13592 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 4903 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificate 4903 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The use of water for the proposed group domestic use shall be limited to the original season of use, April 1 to November 1.
- 5. The rate of diversion for the proposed group domestic use shall be limited to 0.0125 cubic foot per second and shall be further limited to a total volume diverted of 3.5 acre-feet during the time period of April 1 to November 1.

- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion or re-diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1**, **2023**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
