ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. G-61

On August 12, 1965, A. C. and Grayce B. Goodrich filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of the Arnold Irrigation District for the irrigation of, among other lands, 2.0 acres in Block 52, Wiestoria Addition to Bend, Oregon, in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., tabulated in the name of Alva Goodrich, with a date of priority of April 25, 1905. This land also has a supplemental right under permit No. 23256 to the use of the water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir, with a date of priority of February 28, 1913.

The applicants herein propose to transfer the water right appurtenant to the lands above described therefrom, without loss of priority, to 2.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M., more explicitly located as part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point whence the NW corner of Section 12 bears North 57° 01' West, 3,084.00 feet; thence North 89° 21' 41" West, 631.58 feet; thence South 0° 03' 17" West, 431.82 feet; thence South 89° 21' 41" East, 631.58 feet to the West right of way line of the Ward County Road; thence North 0° 03' 17" East, 431.82 feet along said right of way to the point of beginning.

Notice of publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water only.

Dale R. and Lucile M. McMeen, owners of record of the land to which it is proposed to transfer water, have submitted written approval to the change in place of use of water.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District have approved the proposed change in place of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 2.0 acres in Block 52, Wiestoria Addition to Bend, Oregon, in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M. be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 2.0 acres in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M. more explicitly located as part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point whence the NW corner of Section 12 bears North 57° 01' West, 3,084.00 Feet; thence North 89° 21' 41" West, 631.58 feet; thence South 0° 03' 17" West, 431.82 feet; thence South 89° 21' 41" East, 631.58 feet to the West right of way line of the Ward County Road; thence North 0° 03' 17" East, 431.82 feet along said right of way to the point of beginning.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1966.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the land to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Arnold Irrigation District at the time certificate is issued to the District confirming other transfers within the District.
