and the water right appurtenant thereto, that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 1.73 cubic feet per second of the waters of Willamette River for irrigation of 3.3 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W.M., 5.2 acres in SE4 SE4, Section 36, Township 7 South, Range 4 West, W.M., 4.4 acres in NW4 NW4, Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 3 West, W.M., 32.8 acres in NE4 NE4, 18.0 acres in NW4 NE4, 36.0 acres in SW4 NE4, 8.3 acres in SE4 NE4, 7.6 acres in SE4 NW4, 10.0 acres in NE4 SW4 and 12.4 acres in NW4 SE4, Section 1, Township 8 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 27, 1953, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Fred C. Ritner and recorded at page 24252, Volume 17, State Record of Water Hight Certificates.

That part of said water right for the use of not to exceed 0.60 cubic foot per second of the waters of Willamette River for irrigation of 21.2 acres in SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, as projected within Ekin D.L.C. 73, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W.M., 26.6 acres in NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, 0.4 acre in SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, both as projected within Ekin D.L.C. 45, Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 27, 1953, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 24252, Volume 17, State hecord of Water Right Certificates, is not in question in this proceeding.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby OHDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 1.73 cubic feet per second of the waters of Willamette kiver for irrigation of 3.3 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 31, Township 7 South, kange 3 West,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right recorded at page 24252, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to Fred C. Ritner covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the use of not to exceed 0.60 cubic foot per second of the waters of Willamette River for irrigation of 21.2 acres in SW_{4}^{1} , SW_{4}^{1} , as projected within Ekin D.L.C. 73, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W.M., 26.6 acres in IWW_{4}^{1} , IWW_{4}^{2} , 0.4 acres in IWW_{4}^{1} , both as projected within Ekin D.L.C. 45, Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 27, 1953.
