ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the Commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 29926, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.

If is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is cancelled and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
