O R D E R

EXTENDING TIME


The above entitled matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of the Central Oregon Irrigation District which was allowed inchoate water rights by the decree of the Circuit Court in the Deschutes River adjudication proceedings, for extension of time within which to complete the construction work and apply the water to beneficial use of said water rights.

It appearing that the time fixed for the completion of such inchoate rights heretofore extended by the State Engineer expired January 1, 1947, and that said district has not fully completed its inchoate rights although it has made reasonable efforts to reclaim its lands and has used due diligence in the prosecution of the work necessary therefor.

It further appears that the applicant has given notice to the City of Redmond, Oregon, Jefferson Water Conservancy District, Arnold Irrigation District, Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company, Crook County Improvement District No. 1, and the Pacific Light and Power Company, and that over thirty days have expired and no objections have been filed to the approval of said application.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time in which to complete the construction work and applying the water to beneficial use of said inchoate rights of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company be and the same is extended to June 30, 1947.
