On July 18, 1988, Edward R. Ball, representing Strawberry Village Partnership, submitted an affidavit that Strawberry Village Partnership is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the partnership has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2854, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Clifton Cleaver. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from the John Day River, with a date of priority of April 12, 1916, for the irrigation of 0.64 acre in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM, further described as lots 9, 10, 11, and 12 of Block 55, Prairie City Land Company First Addition.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the Commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2854, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.

If is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is cancelled and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
