An affidavit was received from Richard S. and Marian M. O'Connell, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is described by certificate 56286, State Record of water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.57 cubic foot per second from Powder River, a tributary of the Snake River. The date of priority is December 15, 1917.

The abandoned water right is for the purpose of irrigating 45.5 acres. A description of the place of use of the abandoned right and to which it is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 23.5 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 14.0 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 ACRES SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 42 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the water right described herein is cancelled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 56286 is cancelled.
