PLACE OF USE OF WATER)	TRANSFER 5633

On May 9, 1985, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert W. and Kathleen Olson for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tamarack Creek, Springs and Gulch, and Eightmile Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 35096, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Wolf Run Water Users Association, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.625 cubic foot per second from Tamarack Creek, Springs and Gulch, and Eightmile Creek, for irrigation of:

10.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
10.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
10.0 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
10.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
5.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
5.0 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 36
Township 1 South, Range 12 East, WM

with a date of priority of May 3, 1909.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Wolf Run Ditch, from a point located 1600 feet North and 1920 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 11 East, WM.

The applicants herein, contract buyers, with the consent of the owner of the lands above described, propose to transfer the right therefrom to a certain:

10.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
20.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
20.0 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 36
Township 1 South, Range 12 East, WM

Thomas J. Paul, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1987.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change of water right shall be considered perfected, and at a later date, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Wolf Run Irrigation Coop, Inc. confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 35096.
