ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3832

On November 1, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by James C. Anderson for approval of a change in point of diversion from South Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 43621, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Otto P. Brandt, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second from South Yamhill River for irrigation of 1.1 acres in NE¼ SW¾ as projected within Turner D.L.C. No. 55, 8.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE¼ SW¾), 1.0 acre in NE¼ SW¾, as projected within McCane D.L.C. No. 62, 1.6 acres in Lot 2 (NW¼ SW¾), 0.2 acre in NW¼ SW¾, 1.5 acres in SW¾ SW¾, and 10.1 acres in SE¼ SW¾, as projected within McCane D.L.C. No. 62, of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 630 feet North and 630 feet West from the Northwest Corner of McCane D.L.C. No. 62, being within Lot 1 (NW4 SW4) of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 75 feet South and 125 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Graves D.L.C. No. 75, being within the NW_4 SW_4 as projected within Graves D.L.C. No. 75, of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Keith M. Palmer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Otto P. Brandt and recorded at page 43621, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
