Authority

OAR 690-380-6010(6) provides that a point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation if the changes authorized under a transfer are not completed.

Applicant

CITY OF ROSEBURG 900 S.E. DOUGLAS STREET ROSEBURG, OR 97470

Findings of Fact

- 1. On March 23, 1999, the City of Roseburg filed an application to add a point of diversion to a portion of the right under Certificate 65256. The Department assigned the application number T-8224.
- 2. On January 12, 2001, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed additional point of diversion. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 32. Certificate 76681 was issued to describe the portion of the right not modified by T-8224.
- 3. On May 7, 2012, P. Eric Swanson, City Manager for the City of Roseburg, notified the Department that the changes authorized under T-8224 would not be completed and requested that the authorized points of diversion revert back to the original points of diversion.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The additional point of diversion authorized under Application T-8224 is reverted to the points of diversion authorized under the water right prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
